### **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**



Financial exploitation of seniors and vulnerable adults is a matter of great concern for the Iron Mountain-Kingsford Community Federal Credit Union and the financial services industry. To help support our Members, we now have the option to add a Trusted Contact to your personal file with us. Trusted Contact information provides us with a person designated by the Member as a point of contact if we have concerns about financial exploitation. The Trusted Contact person can also act as a resource to assist us if we are unable to reach the Member after multiple attempts or if we have concerns about the Member's health or mental capacity.

Members are not required to provide a Trusted Contact. We do believe it is in the best interest of the Member, regardless of their age or current health status, to provide us with contact information for a person they trust who we may reach out to in a time of need.

Trusted Contacts do NOT have access to your account information nor can they perform transactions on your behalf. They are only used as a resource to help protect you in a time of concern.
