Technology allows us to connect with those we know and love, reconnect with others from the past, and also meet new people. While most of us are aware of the risks associated with communicating with those not personally known to us, there is a substantial population who are not. When criminals identify an at-risk individual, it doesn't take long for them to take advantage of them financially and emotionally.

- Set up multi-factor authentication on all accounts that allow it.
- Examine all email addresses before responding to a message.
- Don't click on anything in unsolicited emails, text messages, or pop-up warnings.
- Be cautious about the information you share in online profiles and social media.
- Don't send payments, wire funds or purchase gift cards for unknown people or organizations that are seeking monetary support and urge immediate action.
- Do not carry on conversations with unknown persons over the phone. It's not rude to JUST HANG UP.

If you do become a victim, TALK about what's happening. Do not be ashamed or embarrassed. These criminals are VERY convincing. Take the power back from them by reinforcing your DEFENSE with family members, friends, and financial institutions on your side. We will fight for you and help stop the criminals in their tracks. You are not alone in this fight.

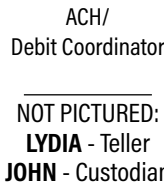

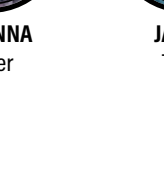
